Why should I book an organized Shore Excursion?

There are a number of advantages to booking a Shore Excursion organized by NCL America, including:

Convenience

Our organized tours maximize your time ashore and eliminate the need for time-consuming, last minute arrangements in port.

We have professional and knowledgeable Shore Excursion staff onboard; available to help you plan your time ashore.

Safety

We have developed Shore Excursion programs with primary consideration for your safety and security.

Value

We review our tours continuously to ensure they are of the highest quality and that prices remain competitive.

How does the Shore Excursion Program work?

Shore Excursions may be reserved in advance. A request form is provided with this document so that you may finalize your plans well in advance of your cruise. This form must be received by NCL America no later than two weeks prior to your sailing date. Do not send payment! Orders will be processed and billed to your onboard account. Shore Excursions are also available for purchase on board. Early in the cruise, the Shore Excursion Manager will present the most up-to-date information on ports and tours. Pick up a Shore Excursion order form at the Shore Excursion Desk. Return the

completed form to the Shore Excursion Desk or Drop Box as soon as possible since all requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Purchases will be billed to your onboard account. Tickets will be delivered to your stateroom.

Are there any restrictions?

An adult must accompany participants under the age of 18 on all tours. There is no charge for children under the age of 2 who do not occupy a separate seat on motorcoach tours. Some tours have additional restrictions implemented for your safety. These may include age, weight, height and/or medical history related restrictions. Please refer to the individual tour description for any restrictions or consult with the onboard Shore Excursion Staff.

Should I tip the guide/driver?

Tipping is strictly optional; however most tour guides and drivers expect and appreciate a modest gratuity. If food and/or beverages are not included as a part of your tour, an additional gratuity for these services is appropriate.

What type of clothing should I wear?

We suggest you wear casual clothing and comfortable, low-heeled walking shoes or sneakers. Depending upon the season or the weather conditions, it may be advisable to bring along sun protection, a sweater, windbreaker and/or rain gear. All tours operate rain or shine. When visiting, places of worship please dress appropriately. And don't forget your camera and plenty of film!

What tours are recommended for families?

Most tours are suitable for families, however, we do not recommend flightseeing tours for children 4 years of age and younger. For a more affordable family experience, many tours offer lower prices for children. Some tours have additional age restrictions implemented for your safety. Please refer to the individual tour description for any additional restrictions or consult with the onboard Shore Excursion Staff.

NOTE: UNDER NCL AMERICA POLICY, ALL PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

Will we miss meals?

With Freestyle Cruising, you don't have to worry about missing a meal. Restaurants offer open seating.

What if we miss the ship?

NCL America does not leave port until all organized tours have returned to the ship. If you leave an organized tour however, or make tour arrangements on your own, please keep the time in mind and return to the ship at least 30 minutes before sailing.

What if I have made my own flight arrangements - will I be able to purchase airport transfers?

Prior to your cruise, transfers may be purchased through NCL America by calling reservations at 1.800.327.7030, or onboard during your cruise at the Shore Excursion Desk.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Responsibility

NCL America, as a convenience to its guests, may sell tickets for Shore Excursions or arrange other services which are operated by independent contractors not affiliated with NCL America. NCL America cannot be responsible for the acts or omissions of these independent contractors. NCL America's responsibility to guests on board NCL America vessels is governed by provisions in the Passenger Ticket Contract and does not extend beyond the vessel.

Cancellation or modification

Cruise schedules are subject to change at the discretion of the Captain, and may occasionally be affected by variations in arrival or departure times, inclement weather, and mechanical or equipment difficulties. NCL America reserves the right to change Shore Excursion prices and itineraries without notice. Excursions are subject to cancellation or modification depending on the number of guests participating. NCL America reserves the right to cancel a Shore Excursion for any reason, including inclement weather, and shall not be liable for any loss to participants. Participants holding tickets for canceled Shore Excursions will receive a full refund. Should it be necessary to abandon a Shore Excursion due to difficulties en route, NCL America will arrange the best possible refund for participants according to the circumstances.

Refunds and cancellation fees

All tours cancelled within 24 hours prior to arrival in the port where the tour is scheduled to operate are non-refundable. Certain tours, such as overland tours, customized tours and tours with theater performances or special events may be subject to different cancellation fees. **ALL HELICOPTER, SCUBA DIVING, SNUBA, SPORTFISHING AND GOLF TOURS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.** Check with the Shore Excursion Desk for details. If a flight departure is cancelled due to weather by the flight company in conjunction with the Shore Excursion Manager, a full credit is given. You can cancel a tour by returning the tour ticket to the Shore Excursion Desk and advising the staff of the cancellation. Refunds will be credited to the guest's onboard account.

Prices

Prices include meals, refreshments as indicated in the tour description and entrance fees, unless otherwise noted. There is no charge for children under the age of 2 who do not occupy a separate seat on a motorcoach tour. Children's prices are only available as indicated on the order form. Participants under the age of 12 pay child prices and participants 12 years of age and older pay adult prices. Due to weight and balance limitations as well as passenger safety and comfort, helicopter guests weighing 250 pounds (113kg) or more (fully dressed), are charged an additional surcharge to reserve extra space on the helicopter and all flightseeing tours. All prices are in U.S. dollars.

Prices on the order form DO NOT INCLUDE the additional 4.166% Hawaiian State Tax that is assessed on all Shore Excursions onboard.

Tour Descriptions, Durations and Departure Times

The tour descriptions are as current and accurate as possible considering that this information is published several months prior to your cruise. Please note that occasionally changes in the description do occur. Any significant changes will be noted on the NCL America website. Some tours will operate in an order that is different from that presented in the booklet. This helps to alleviate crowding at local venues. The information in the booklet is designed to help you select the excursions most suited to your interests. The individual tour descriptions include approximate durations and can be found under each tour name. Please note that departure times are subject to change. Please check the NCL America website (ncl.com/hawaiishorex) for the most current descriptions.

Insurance

The duties and liabilities of a particular tour operator and the scope and extent of the operator's insurance coverage may vary. Because of this, many travel professionals advise their clients to strongly consider purchasing cancellation insurance and a short-term personal health and accident policy from a reputable insurance company before leaving home.

Tour operators

Tour operators have the right to require any individual to withdraw from a tour at any time if they deem the individual's conduct detrimental to or incompatible with the interests, comfort, well-being or harmony of the group as a whole. Tour operators reserve the right to alter or adjust itineraries to meet local conditions for participant safety and convenience. Neither NCL America nor local tour operators can extend financial reimbursement to compensate for a participant's disappointment in the event circumstances beyond the reasonable control of NCL America or the tour operator make it impossible to provide services as intended.

Transportation

All tours include round trip transportation. The best available local transportation is utilized in every port of call. However, quests should recognize that quality standards may vary. Air-conditioned vehicles are not always available. Cars, vans or taxis are often used in ports where coach transport is

Guests with Disabilities

While NCL America strives to make its Shore Excursion program available to all its guests, inherent tour venue limitations and/or tour operator limitations exist that are beyond NCL America's control that limit the ability of guests with disabilities to participate in certain Shore Excursions. We urge such guests to advise the Shore Excursion department of disabilities when pre-booking tours and to further meet with the Shore Excursion staff on board to discuss their disabilities as they relate with the unique characteristics of each Shore Excursion. We typically recommend independent transportation for the comfort and convenience of guests with disabilities.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

During your cruise, you may be presented with opportunities to purchase tours/guide services from outside companies. In the interest of your personal safety, we request you proceed with caution as some operators may not be licensed. For your information, NCL America uses only insured, reputable and fully licensed tour operators in our Shore Excursion program.

TOUR INDICATORS / SYMBOLS

Level 1: Tours with this designation involve walking over relatively level terrain. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

Level 2: Tours with this designation can involve a considerable amount of physical activity such as walking over cobblestones or uneven surfaces, climbing stairs or steep terrain, swimming in a light current, or bicycle riding. They are not recommended for guests with

walking difficulties. Comfortable sturdy shoes are recommended.

Tours with this designation involve physical exertion for extended periods of time. The terrain may be uneven or steep. They are Level 3:

recommended only for the physically fit and adventurous traveler.

Guests with Disabilities: Accommodates quests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs, provided there is a companion to assist them in and out of motorcoaches or other transportation or with the navigation of venues with uneven terrain and/or steps insofar as some or all of the

destinations on this tour do not provide special access and/or equipment. Wheelchairs must be collapsible.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE ONBOARD SHORE EXCURSION STAFF OF ANY SPECIAL NEEDS OR CONCERNS AT LEAST 48

HOURS PRIOR TO THE REQUESTED TOUR DEPARTURE.

All participants must be certified Scuba divers and must have logged a Scuba dive or completed a refresher course within the past C-card: 12 months. You must present a nationally recognized Certification Card and fill out a short medical history and release form at the

time of booking. If you are thinking of participating in the Scuba program and have a known medical condition, please get a clearance letter from your physician stating that you have no restrictions to dive. This should be done prior to taking your cruise and the original letter should be brought along with you. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 10-11 years may only dive to a maximum depth of 12 meters or 40 feet and must be accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 12-14 years may dive to a depth of 18 meters or 60 feet, again accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. A parent or guardian must accompany any diver

under the age of 18.

Flight: All helicopters are loaded according to weight, for the safety and balance of the helicopter as well as for passenger safety and

comfort. FAA requires passenger names and weights for weight and balance calculations and flight manifesting. Fully dressed body weights are required prior to check in. Please notify our Shore Excursion staff on board the ship if weighing 250 lbs. (113kg) or more (fully dressed), as you will be subject to an additional surcharge for a comfort seat. Inaccurate weight reporting by guest may lead to denial of tour based on weight/balance of aircraft. Seating configuration in most helicopters are 2 passengers up front with the pilot and 4 behind. Because tour helicopters resemble airborne bubbles, the views are excellent no matter where you sit. If a flight departure is cancelled due to weather by the flight company in conjunction with the Shore Excursion Manager, a full credit is given.

TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

HILO, HAWAII

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK & RAINBOW FALLS

Approximate Duration: 6 1/2 hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities, Meal

Your tour begins with a short drive to Wailuku River State Park and Rainbow Falls. The 80-foot falls cascade into a circular pool in the Wailuku River and, as they hit the water below, rainbows are often flung into the mist. Your tour continues to the spectacular Nani Mau Botanical Garden before an approximate 60-minute drive to Volcanoes National Park, where 70 million years of volcanism are on display. Admire the remarkable view of Kilauea Volcano, earth's most active volcano, as you enjoy a buffet lunch. Then get ready for a fascinating drive along the 11-mile Crater Rim to enjoy a unique view of this volcanic landscape and learn about Madame Pele, Hawaii's Goddess of Fire. Then trace the birth of the Hawaiian Islands when you visit Hawaii Volcano Observatory and the Jaggar Museum. You will also have the opportunity to walk through the Thurston Lava Tube before a visit at Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory, where the tasty nut can be found coated in everything from chocolate to Kona coffee.

Note: Some walking on uneven ground is required. While at Volcanoes National Park, you will not see molten lava. Thurston Lave Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathways and steps.

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK ODYSSEY

Approximate Duration: 4 3/4 hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities

Learn about Hawaii's Goddess of Fire, Madame Pele, as you explore Volcanoes National Park on an approximate 45-minute drive taking you along the Crater's Rim. Enjoy a unique view of this volcanic landscape. Standing at just over 5,000 feet, Kilauea is not the tallest volcano on the Big Island, but it is certainly the most active. Pass the Halemaumau Fire Pit and the Kilauea Iki Crater before stopping at the Thurston Lava Tube, where a short walk gives you the opportunity for an up-close view of an extinct lava tube. This tour also visits the Hawaii Volcano Observatory and Jaggar Museum, where you'll view exhibits, geological displays and working seismographic equipment showing the geological changes caused over the years by this active volcano. Then visit the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory, where the tasty nut can be found coated in everything from chocolate to Kona coffee.

Note: Some walking on uneven ground is required. While at Volcanoes National Park, you will not see molten lava. Thurston Lave Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathway and steps.

NANI MAU GARDENS & AKAKA FALLS

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2

The windward side of The Big Island is said to be a gift of nature. Departing the pier, you'll drive through Hilo's scenic Bay along Banyan Drive and pass Liliuokalani Park, filled with an amazing variety of tropical plants and flowers. Continuing on the Hawaii Belt Road, traveling in the direction of the Hamakua Coast, you'll pass through small villages en route to Akaka Falls, located on the slopes of dormant Mauna Kea Volcano. Here, water plunges over 420 feet in a sheer drop over a volcanic cliff. Next, it's on to the Nani Mau Botanical Garden and you'll discover why the 'Big Island' has another nickname: 'Orchid Island'. Before returning to the pier, you will also visit Big Island Candies, where you may sample Kona coffee, hand-made cookies and candies, a big favorite to this island.

Note: Some walking over damp and slippery surfaces, including several steps, is required. This tour is not wheelchair accessible due to the pathways and steps at Akaka Falls.

MAUNA KEA - WORLD'S TALLEST MOUNTAIN

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Restrictions

Mauna Kea Volcano measures 32,000 feet from its base to its summit at 13,796 feet above sea level. This makes it the tallest mountain in the world, and the most sought after astronomical site, with 13 telescopes representing 12 countries scanning the heavens and looking beyond the stars to galaxies far beyond. Home to the most powerful observatories and telescopes, including the Keck Telescope which has the world's largest mirror, it is also home to the cultural heritage of the Hawaiian people. During the last Ice Age, Mauna Kea was heavily glaciated and with the mixing of ice and molten lava it formed a dense rock that ancient Hawaiians quarried to make durable blades and adzes. Your "Sea to Sky" experience will start as you depart from the pier in an air-conditioned 4 x 4 van, making your way through the historic town of Hilo northward towards Mauna Kea. The ancient Hawaiians also considered it the home of the Female Deities, and of their spirituality that brought life to all below. It was the meeting place of Heaven and Earth and the burial place of High Chiefs. The view atop Mauna Kea can only be described as "Majestic", with the clouds often below you. This tour includes a stop at Onizuka Center for International Astronomy at 9,200 feet and the world's largest telescope at Keck Observatory (weekdays only). A journey few experience and none forget, the closest you'll get to the sky without leaving earth.

Note: Participants must be over 16 years of age (State Requirement). Sandwiches, water and snacks provided. The Visitor Center also has coffee, candies and souvenirs. Oxygen is carried for emergencies. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women, persons suffering from respiratory disorders or heart problems. Jacket, long pants and comfortable shoes are recommended. Warm parkas are provided, as the summit may be cold. During winter, rare overnight storms can close the summit road without warning. In these cases we will provide an alternate tour but cannot visit the Summit Observatory area. When Keck is closed we will try for a visit to one of the other open facilities.

DISCOVER HILO - WAVES & WATERFALLS

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Level 2

Experience all of the best things about Hilo in one tour – visit Akaka Falls, the Tsunami Museum, the Shinmachi Memorial, the historic King Kamehameha Statue and a stop at Big Island Candies to stock up on world-famous hand-made Hawaiian treats – all in the comfort of an air-conditioned mini-coach. This tour takes you along the scenic "Old Road" through lush rainforest en route to magnificent Akaka Falls plunging 420 feet over the sheer cliffs of dormant Mauna Kea Volcano – take this opportunity to photograph some of the island's most dramatic tropical foliage. At the Tsunami Museum you will watch an educational film about the awesome power of the Tsunami, including real footage of the Tsunami of 1946 that devastated so much of Hilo, and listen to informative talks given by locals. Now your visit to the beautiful Shinmachi Memorial – erected in honor of the many residents of Hilo who lost their lives to the Tsunami of 1946 – will be even more powerful, as you will understand the magnitude of the devastation caused by the powerful tsunami. Now you can say you have really "done Hilo!"

Note: Participants should wear comfortable walking shoes. Dress in layers appropriate for variable weather conditions, including rain. Some walking over damp and slippery surfaces, including several steps is required. This tour is not wheelchair accessible due to pathways and steps at Akaka Falls.

WINDWARD COAST & WATERFALLS

Approximate Duration: 6 1 /2 hours

Level 1, Meal, Age Restrictions

Follow the trade winds as you venture along the coastal lands of Hawaii's oldest volcanic mountains. Along the way, enjoy easy walking explorations to little-visited yet accessible waterfalls and coastal areas. Scenic old roads wind along towering cliffs and rainforest streams taking you toward magnificent Waipi'o Valley – the largest valley on the Island of Hawaii. On the return leg, you will enjoy a walk through the heritage town of Honoka'a, with its charming old-style storefronts. En route, you will stop at Laupahoehoe Point with its spectacular shoreline; Waikaumalo Park with its scenic stream and tropical plants; and several beautiful waterfalls, one of which has amazing botanical gardens. Enjoy a picnic lunch at one of these scenic areas. Your experienced guide will provide you with fascinating information about these beautiful places, stories of the people on this land and the dramatic work of nature along this stretch of coast. Be sure to bring your camera!

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and able to walk short distances. Wear sturdy walking shoes and sunscreen. Rain protection is provided when necessary. This is not a hiking tour. A gourmet deli-style picnic lunch is included.

COASTAL HILO & BOTANICAL GARDENS

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Level 2

Located on Onomea Bay, this world-renowned tropical garden is a nature preserve that is acclaimed by visitors as 'the most beautiful area in Hawaii'. En route, your narrated tour takes you through the Japanese-style Liliuokalani Gardens, along Hilo Bay and the lush Hamakua Coast to Onomea Bay. Here, in the Hawaii Tropical Botanical Garden, more than 2,500 species of tropical plant life have been assembled from regions all over the world; plants are labeled for identification. A stroll through the incomparable Orchid Garden is a true photographer's paradise. You'll receive a map of the garden trails at the Visitor Center, and then enjoy your time wandering the garden grounds on your own, taking photographs or simply enjoying the incredible beauty. A great add on to your day!

Note: Wear comfortable walking shoes. There is approximately one mile of walking.

HAWAIIAN ECO-SAFARI

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 1, Meal

Enjoy a day of exploration and learn about the formation, population, history, and culture of the Hawaiian Islands. Gain an understanding of the volcanic forces that created the islands, and continue to shape the island of Hawaii today. Learn about the native flora and fauna as well as the many species which have affected the natural course of the island's eco-system. Visit the Panaewa Rainforest Zoo, the only rainforest zoo in America, where you will see a collection of rare Hawaiian birds as well as many other exhibits. Namaste, the white tiger is always a crowd favorite. Tour the arboretum at Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Farm's Visitors Center, and learn about native and introduced plants. The gift shop at the Visitor Center is full of tasty treats to sample and take home. At Lava Tree Park, take a short walk to view the "lava trees" which are a lasting example of what happens when a lava flow overruns a rainforest. On the way to Ahalanui Park, you will view the Kapoho Lava Flow, which destroyed the village of Kapoho in 1960. Enjoy a relaxing dip in the geo-thermal pool, which is fed by fresh water heated by the volcano, and makes for water temperatures as high as 95 degrees, or just take in the breathtaking ocean views.

Note: Includes a picnic deli-style lunch.

SECRETS OF PUNA

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal

Climb aboard a luxury 4 x 4 SUV for a very memorable and exciting adventure to Puna, located on the southeast corner of the Big Island and home to some of the world's most spectacular natural sights. Kilauea Volcano has been erupting continuously since January 3, 1983 and has added more than 600 acres of land to the island. This creation also came at a price. As we set off on our journey, sit back and relax as we play for you an audio visual onboard showing footage of the eruptions and hearing firsthand stories of life in Kalapana from former residents who witnessed the destruction of their homes and lives only 15 years ago. During this venture you will visit the site of what was once know to be the finest black sand beach in the world, Kaimu, entombed since 1990 under 75 feet of lava. Then we stop at dramatic 75-foot high lava cliff overlooking the brilliant blue waters of the Pacific. Here you will enjoy a gourmet lunch and refreshments including champagne and locally brewed mehana beer while you admire the views. After lunch we continue on to the village of Kapoho, destroyed by the eruption in 1960 before making a stop at the secret volcanically heated saltwater pool, where you can snorkel if you wish or just take a swim to cool off. Our final destination is to Lava Tree State Park for a short walk, where in 1790 a lava flow overran the jungle and Ohia trees encasing them forever in lava.

Note: Participants must be in good health and able to walk over uneven ground. We recommend you wear a swimsuit under comfortable clothing, walking shoes, a light raincoat and bring along sunscreen and a hat. Snorkel gear and beach towels are all provided. Lunch, snacks and beverages are also included throughout the day. This tour is exclusive and only accommodate up to 7 people per vehicle.

EXPLORE THE LAND OF FROZEN FIRE

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2

From the pier, in an air-conditioned van, you head to the "Wild West" Pahoa Town and Lava Tree State Park, on the eastern rift zone of Kilauea. In 1960 the massive Kapoho Lava flow engulfed the area with enough lava to pave an eight-lane highway four times around the world. Today you can see the lava tree molds formed when lava surrounds a tree, freezes against it then drains away. You'll visit Ahalanui warm springs, with its volcanically heated 90-degree water, then drive along a stretch of highway that often floods at high tide. Along the way and at brief stops, you will view the dramatic and beautiful scenery formed when lava meets the sea: cliffs, lava tubes and blow holes. At Kaimu, once the site of a famous black sand beach and a small town, both destroyed by a 1990 lava flow, a stop is made where you can walk on the "Frozen Fire" and view the active volcanic vent in the distance. You will visit a standing survivor of the eruption, Uncle Robert's Hawaiian Village and Snack Shop, where you can purchase beverages, and view a picture exhibit showing information of the lava you just walked on and the area prior to the 1990 lava flow.

Note: Some walking on uneven ground is required. Participants must wear closed-toe shoes. We recommend that you wear comfortable clothing.

CIRCLE OF FIRE HELICOPTER

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Flight

See earth's most geologically active environment, the Kilauea Volcano, on a thrilling helicopter ride. This remarkable flightseeing tour emphasizes the most current areas of volcanic activity. You will fly over Kilauea's most recent eruption sites and follow the surface activity down to the devastated village of Kalapana. View lava flows, the Puna Forest and black sand beaches, formed of lava that has been cooled by the water and ground smooth as glass by the ocean. In the course of your tour, you will receive an informative commentary from your tour guide/pilot over an individual Bose headset.

Note: Approximate flight time is 45 minutes. THIS TOUR IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

DISCOVER KILAUEA - TWO WAYS

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Explore the natural wonder of Kilauea in two unique ways! Kilauea is the most active volcano on the planet, continuously erupting since 1983. Leaving Hilo we travel south to Kalapana, while the story of this region as told by former residents, plays on the onboard multi-screen video system. Approaching the area we go off road across recent lava flows to this ancient Hawaiian fishing village that was destroyed in 1990. Our stop here allows you time to explore the buried Kalapana and you can look for surface outbreaks and ocean entries. Continuing the journey we travel to the Kazumura Cave system, the longest cave in the world with over 40 miles discovered and waiting to be explored! Lava once flowed through this cave system from Kilauea on its way to the sea. Your expert guide will be there to greet you on arrival and take you down into the mountain for a subterranean expedition of Kilauea you'll never forget! Stalagmites, stalactites and flowstones are just some of the amazing natural formations left behind from the searing heat of lava flows. The cool forest hovering over the cave is a spectacular backdrop for a moment of relaxation and refreshments after your cave adventure, the perfect place to enjoy organic tropical fruit salad complimented by your choice of beverage including water, juice, soft drinks and locally brewed beer and champagne. This is certainly the perfect way to end your two way discovery of Kilauea.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. This tour requires a moderate amount of activity; participants must be in good physical condition and comfortable with walking over uneven terrain. If you have any back problems, existing heart conditions or are pregnant, this tour is not for you. You must wear sturdy closed-toe shoes; we recommend comfortable clothing, sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. You will not see molten lava on this tour; natural features change daily.

HILO DIVE IN TO ADVENTURE™

KILAUEA LAVA VIEWING ADVENTURE HIKE

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 3, Meal, Age Restrictions

The site of flowing lava is incredible, and this is your best chance to see it! You will travel 51 miles from Hilo in an air-conditioned van that will take you up 4,000 feet to Kilauea Volcano and back down to the sea. Here on the coast is where you will have the best chance to see flowing lava. For 22 years Kilauea has been erupting with lava moving slowly back and forth along a 10-mile stretch as it enters the sea. You will walk on the newest land on earth, in some cases formed only hours before your arrival and still hot. Time permitting after the hike you will also visit other park features.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Infants are not permitted even if carried by adults. You must wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes and we highly recommend comfortable clothing in layers, long pants, sturdy covered walking shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. This is a heavy hiking tour that is approximately two to six miles roundtrip and involves walking at a good pace over uneven surfaces with large angle changes that require good balance. Although seeing lava is the goal, red lava viewing is up to Mother Nature and not guaranteed. When there are pauses in lava flow, or it is too distant to reach, we will visit the most recent flow sites. Due to natural sulfur gases this tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with respiratory or heart problems. Due to the type of ground you are hiking over, cotton gloves are provided. Lunch, including a sandwich, snacks and bottled water are included.

KILAUEA VOLCANO BIKING

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2, Age Restrictions

The best way to see Hawaii Volcanoes National Park is on a bike! Your exciting day begins with a scenic narrated drive from the cruise ship pier to the Visitor's Center at the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park where you will receive a detailed orientation and safety briefing and be fitted with a 21-speed, comfort-designed mountain bike and safety equipment. Your eight-mile bike ride around the Kilauea Caldera is on paved roads and takes place over mostly level or downhill terrain over 2 to 2 1/2 hours. The ride is punctuated with scenic view stops and short walks to the Kilauea Iki Overlook, the famous Thurston Lava Tube, Pu'u Pua'i Overlook and the Halema'uma'u Overlook, just to name a few. The ride includes two short uphill sections. If you

do not wish to ride the hills you may ride in the van at any time. After your ride, stop at the Jaggar Museum where you will see videos of the volcano erupting. The Jaggar Museum is also home to many seismographs, which monitor every twitch of the earth. Throughout the tour your guide will share with you history and geology of the area during the frequent stops along the way – an exciting and active way to spend the day at the volcano! Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and comfortable riding a bike. Elevation is 4,000 feet so wear comfortable clothing in layers, covered

shoes and bring sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. Bike, helmet, gloves and rain jacket or ponchos are provided, as well as bottled water and snacks. Tour vans will follow during bike ride; cameras and other personal belongings may be left in van if you wish. Natural sulfur gases may affect those with respiratory problems. You will not see molten lava on this tour.

WAIPIO VALLEY ADVENTURES

Visit one of the most beautiful valleys and secret spots in the Hawaiian Islands! Considered by many as one of most beautiful places on earth, Waipio is often referred to as the Valley of the Kings since it was once home to many of the Ali'i (royalty). Here, in 1780, King Kamehameha was proclaimed future ruler of the Hawaii Islands. In addition to its beauty and history, the valley is home to many stories of the gods and the site of many important heiau (shrine). Your adventure begins with a scenic drive up the Hamakua Coast to Waipi'o; lush and green the valley is remote and not easily accessible to the public. Let your imagination come alive as your Hawaii-born guide's show you the wonders of this area on a number of fun activities: via Horseback, Mule-Drawn wagon or in a 4 X 4 van to the Valley of the Kings. From the lookout, breathtaking views unfold before you: the ocean with its black sand beach, the valley's floor with its steep cliffs, taro fields, tropical plants, and conditions permitting you may even view cascading waterfalls. Upon arrival at Waipio, a stop will be made at the Valley Artworks Gallery (except on the Mule Drawn Wagon), where restrooms facilities, local handy-craft souvenirs and refreshments are available for purchase. You will then transfer by van to the departure point for the tour you chose. Here on this sacred mountaintop, is where you will find the spirit of Hawaii.

Note: Tours operate weather permitting – tropical rains may force cancellation. Waterfalls are not always visible. TOURS TO WAIPIO VALLEY ARE NOT AVAILABLE ON SUNDAYS.

WAIPIO VALLEY RIM HORSEBACK RIDE

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Restrictions

Saddle up and explore the trails above Waipio Valley on a two-hour horseback ride along the rim of this sacred valley. The sugar cane companies have long restricted entry into this area, but recently the incredible views have become accessible to those on horseback.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Maximum weight is 230 lbs. Long pants are highly recommended due to the coarseness of horse's hair. Bring a hat and sunscreen. Closed-toe shoes are required. This tour is not advisable for pregnant women.

WAIPIO VALLEY ATV TOUR

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Restrictions

THIS TOUR IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE

Spectacular scenery awaits you on this adventure as you drive your own four wheeled ATV along the mountain ridge, high above the valley that stretches out to a black sand beach and the crashing waves of the Pacific.

Note: Participants must drive their own ATV, be at least 16 years of age and provide valid I.D. Minimum weight: 100 lbs, Maximum weight: 250 lbs. A long-sleeved shirt, long pants and closed-toe shoes are required for protection against flying rocks, etc. Top of the line, fully automatic and user-friendly ATVs are used and a short safety course will also be given prior to your ride. This tour is not advisable for pregnant women.

WAIPIO VALLEY MULE-DRAWN WAGON

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 1. Weight Restrictions

Step back in time and visit Waipi'o Valley as few have - in a mule-drawn wagon. Here about its history, legends and spiritual significance. Built especially for Waipio's rough terrain the wagon has cushioned seats and GM shocks for a comfortable ride.

Note: Wear comfortable clothes and good walking shoes. Maximum weight permitted is 300 lbs. Please advise if over 250 lbs., for passenger comfort.

WAIPIO VALLEY OF THE KINGS EXPEDITION

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 1

Explore the beauty of Waipio Valley via 4 x 4 van guided by your Hawaiian native-born guide. Drive over backcountry roads to scenic points and sites of historical significance not accessible by the general public. Surrounded by vertical cliffs and lush foliage, this is a true glimpse into the untouched Hawaii. Note: Participants should expect to drive on uneven, bumpy terrain and through streams in the valley floor.

KILAUEA VOLCANO HIKING

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 3, Meal, Age Restrictions

See Kilauea Volcano and hike directly to the source that created the Hawaiian Islands. Incredibly enough, the land you cross gets younger as the airconditioned van climbs from the Port of Hilo to the 4,000 foot summit of Kilauea Volcano and Hawaii Volcanoes National Park where new land is brought from the earth's interior to the surface. This is a rare and unforgettable experience in a very special place! In the park your naturalist guide will provide you with details about the volcanic activity, the plants and human history. In addition, you will learn of the cultural significance of the area and hear ancient legends of Pele, the fire goddess. Kilauea remains a sacred place for many Hawaiians. Immersed in the terrain and flora of Kilauea Volcano, you'll hike through lava fields, rainforest, near steam vents and through a lava tube. When flowing lava is accessible we will get you as close as safely

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, able to walk on rocky and uneven terrain and capable of a four-mile walk into a crater some 400 feet in depth. We recommend you wear comfortable clothing in layers, sturdy covered walking shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. Although seeing lava is the goal, red lava viewing is up to Mother Nature and not guaranteed. This tour is not recommended for those with respiratory or heart problems. Lunch, bottled water and all gear and accessories are provided.

OCEAN CLIFF'S ATV

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours AVAILABLE ONBOARD ONLY

Level 2

Your day in paradise begins with a narrated scenic motor coach ride up the Hamakua Coast to the ranch. While on your own ATV view marvels like the old irrigation lifeline of Hawaii's sugar cane, Hamakua Ditch, View the reservoir where Hamakua Sunfish are raised for consumption. Enjoy panoramic sloping views as we ride on lower grass-lands where donkeys known as Kona Nightingales bray their evening songs and Waipi'o Hawaiian Horses frolic. Towards the end of your day enjoy a short break to survey the blue-greens of the distant Waipi'o Valley north face.

Note: Closed-toed shoes and long pants are required. To drive your own ATV guest must be at least 16 years of age, with valid ID.

Get the best of both worlds as we show you the "must see" natural features, as well as hidden gems other tours pass by. Step back in time as we share our favorite stories and legends of the native Hawaiian people. Catch a glimpse of one of our endemic forest honeycreepers or feel the scorching heat of a black pahoehoe desert. You'll connect with your surroundings through a wealth of knowledge on the geology, biology and natural history of our unique volcanic island. Touring with our guides is like having your own personal park ranger! If lava location and time permits, we'll also travel down the scenic Chain of Craters Road to visit actively flowing lava. There's no better place on earth to witness the creation of land and awesome power of volcanoes than at Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and able to comfortably walk one to three miles on rocky/uneven terrain. Your adventure begins from a black sand beach in the heart of Hilo, just a short distance from the cruise ship pier. Enjoy a great time on the water with fun guides and amazing views – look out for a glimpse of the Mauna Kea Summit. Hilo is situated in a portion of Hawaii's rainforest country, so be prepared for plenty of rainbows and lush tropical coastline. Your kayaking excursion will take you out past Coconut Island and along Hilo's shoreline with magnificent views of the Wailoa Park Estuary and the Wailuku River Waterfall, where the 18-mile river reaches the ocean.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and in good physical condition. Maximum weight allowed is 250 lbs. This tour is not recommended for those with back problems or heart conditions. Departing from the pier, you will drive directly to Pearl Harbor and the Arizona Memorial Visitor Center. After a short orientation, a motor launch will take you to the memorial, which straddles the hull of the *USS Arizona*. This is the final resting place for many of the crewmen killed on December 7, 1941. Following this sobering visit, continue to the landmarks of downtown Honolulu. Enjoy a stop at the statue of the great ruler, King Kamehameha. You will see Iolani Palace, the residence of Hawaii's monarchy, and Kawaiahao, Hawaii's oldest church, as well as Washington Place, once home to Queen Liliuokalani. Your tour concludes with a drive through the Punchbowl National Cemetery, set in the crater of an extinct volcano. Then relax and enjoy the panoramic city views on your drive to the airport.

More great scenery awaits at Makapu'u Lookout, followed by an ancient archeological site and former war temple. As you wind your way along the island, your guide will tell you about the geography, food, plants, and birds. Your final highlight will be the Pali Lookout, located high in the Ko'olau Mountains. Legend holds that Hawaii's warriors once fell to their deaths from these windswept, cloud-covered cliffs.

PEARL HARBOR & USS MISSOURI

Celebrate the honor, valor and courage of the U.S. servicemen who served during World War II on this special tour. This nostalgic journey takes you to the two places that marked the beginning and the end of the war for the United States – Pearl Harbor and the USS Missouri. At the site of Pearl Harbor you'll visit the Arizona Memorial where the remains of the USS Arizona lie silent beneath the waves. The historic events of the 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor will unfold in detailed narrations and photos. While at Pearl Harbor, you'll travel across the Ford Island Bridge to the historic USS Missouri battleship, nicknamed the 'Mighty Mo'. It was on the decks of this celebrated warship that the treaty ending World War II was signed. Explore the

passages, rooms and corridors on a self-guided tour. From Pearl Harbor you will enjoy the scenic sights with a drive through metropolitan Honolulu. This tour may operate in reverse order.

DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER AT SEA LIFE PARK

Your adventure begins with a narrated island tour to Sealife Park. Upon arrival, a quick orientation will give you an overview of the park and its amenities. Begin the day by waving to the incredible penguins and then enjoying a dolphin show at Dolphin Cove. Then it's on to the Hawaiian Reef Aquarium, which offers a close-up view of Hawaii's underwater ecosystem where over 2,000 reef animals and organisms reside in a 300,000-gallon aquarium. Then it's on to the Kolohe Kai Surf Club for a hilarious sea lion show. Next it is the Sea Turtle Lagoon, a fascinating exhibit area that more importantly doubles as a breeding sanctuary for the endangered Hawaiian green sea turtle. Now it is time for the highlight of your day – the dolphin encounter. From a waist deep platform you will caress, kiss and observe the dolphins while they perform high-energy behaviors. For those who feel comfortable, there is the opportunity to move off the platform into slightly deeper water to participate in some fun activities while swimming with the dolphins.

Note: This tour is available for guests returning to the ship or with flights departing Honolulu after 5:00 pm. Children under 8 years of age and/or under 55 inches in height must be accompanied by a paying adult. No pregnant women allowed in the dolphin encounter part of the tour. EXPLORE THE FAMOUS NORTH SHORE

Starting with a drive over the Ko'olau Mountains to the windward side, your first stop is the fabled Valley of the Temples, where you visit the picturesque Byodo Temple located at the base of stunning 2,000-foot lush green cliffs. Driving on along the scenic shores of Kahana Bay, you arrive at Laie Point, a great location to observe several native plant and seabird species. Continuing north to Kahuku, you will visit several shrimp farms to see endangered wetland birds, including the black-neck stilt, Hawaiian coot and moorhen. Next stop is the world famous Sunset Beach and Banzai Pipeline where incredible waves thrill viewers, especially between November and April, then it's on to Turtle Beach where you will stop to observe rare green sea turtles. Traveling south, you'll arrive at the historic village of Haleiwa.

Note: This tour is available for quests returning to the ship or with flights departing Honolulu after 6:00 pm.

HIDDEN TREASURES & LANDMARKS

Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities

Uncover the rich history and customs of the Hawaiian people and its famous landmarks. Departing from the pier we take a scenic drive through the historic district of downtown Honolulu, passing the statues of King Kamehameha, the ruler who united the Hawaiian Islands into one nation; 'lolani Palace, the only royal residence on American soil, where Hawaii's last reigning monarch, Queen Liliuokalani ruled until 1893; The Hawaii State Capital, Mission Houses and Kawaiahao Church. The Hawaii State Capital was completed in 1969 and replaced the 'lolani Palace as the seat of government for Hawaii's political arena. Its unique architecture reflects Hawaii's geography, the legislative cambers represent volcanoes, the pillars mimic palm trees and the surrounding pool symbolizes the sea. From downtown we then proceed to National Cemetery of the Pacific, otherwise known as "Punchbowl"; this extinct volcanic crater is the burial site for more than 33,000 men and women who fought for the United States in World War II, the Korean and Vietnam Wars. Continuing our scenic route we then take a drive to the Pali Lookout, for a picture perfect view of the islands Windward side. Coming down from the Pali we make our way to the Bishop Museum, where you will be greeted by a guide who will take you through the main showcase, unfolding 2,000 years of Hawaiian history. Then get ready to discover Old Hawaii at Pu'uhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park. KONA COAST & THE PARKER RANCH

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities

Go upcountry to the home of Hawaii's cowboy, the Paniolo. From the pier, you will travel through historic Kona and along Hawaii's beautiful sundrenched Gold Coast. Your guide will point out many historic sights, pausing at Kailua's Mokuaikaua Christian Church believed to be Hawaii's first Christian Church. You will pass Hulihe'e Palace, once the summer home of Hawaiian royalty, en route to the ancient Royal Heiau called Pu'ukohola. This ancient temple, said to have been built by the great King Kamehameha I, is now a national historical site. Leaving the coast, you will head up the verdant slopes of dormant volcano Mauna Kea to Waimea and Kohala cattle country. Here, the rolling green pastures are home to the 220,000-acre Parker Ranch, Hawaii's biggest ranch, and the Spanish-trained cowboys who work there, called Paniolo. The ranch was founded over 150 years ago by John Palmer Parker, and grew from two acres granted by King Kamehameha III. You will visit the Visitor Center, where displays detail six generations of Parker family life. Highlights of your visit include a call at Mana, the Parker's original koa wood cabin, and its later replacement, Pu'u'opelu, filled with precious art works and Venetian glass collected by Parker heirs.

Coffee, Chocolate and Vanilla! Journey into the rich volcanic estates of Kona to visit the Holualoa Kona Coffee Estate; walk the grounds, tour the processing facilities, watch the coffee as it's being roasted, and sample gourmet coffee. The second stop is a tour through the Original Hawaiian Chocolate Factory. Learn how they cultivate the very best Cacao pods and beans and turn them into decadent dark and milk chocolate bars. Tour through the Cacao orchard; see demonstrations on how the Cacao pods are processed then it's tasting time. From here we then head north along the slopes of Mauna Kea to the Hawaiian Vanilla Company; featured on the Food Network, Travel Channel and the Discovery Channel. The Hawaiian Vanilla Company is the first commercially grown vanilla farm in the U.S. Upon arrival you will be served a refreshing beverage and a five-course gourmet lunch that features locally grown produce and Hawaiian Vanilla in exciting new pairings. See the vanilla planifolia orchids; smell pure Hawaiian Vanilla beans, taste savory dishes and decadent desserts made with Hawaiian Vanilla.

Your beach blast begins with a 30-minute scenic drive via air-conditioned motorcoach displaying views across the unique lava fields of the Kohala Coast. Upon arrival your experienced and friendly beach crew will be there to greet you and assist in getting you out to enjoy the unlimited use of all the fun beach toys and activities available. Whether you want to try your hand in kayaking, snorkeling or biking across the sheltered bay on floating hydro-bikes, the day is yours to enjoy. You can even enjoy the underwater world of Anaeho'omalu Bay by boarding the glass-bottomed boat with a fully narrated tour over protected coral gardens viewing unique tropical fish and endangered green sea turtles.

Note: We recommend you wear your swimsuit with a cover-up, and bring sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses, towel and a camera. Golf on the slopes of Mauna Kea, 2,000 feet above the Pacific in a beautiful mountain environment. Rolling fairways and numerous water hazards make this a challenging course for all level of players. The undulating bent grass greens are in excellent condition and the signature par 3, 17th hole, features a true island green. Big Island Country Club is at a higher elevation than other courses, so don't forget some warmer clothes.

KONA DIVE IN TO ADVENTURE™

VALLEY WATERFALL HIKING ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Restrictions

Treat yourself to this once-in-a-lifetime Hawaii experience in the heart of Pololu Valley. Imagine walking along a historic, cliffside trail 1,000 feet above the valley floor. Along the way you'll encounter beautiful waterfalls and breathtaking views while your naturalist guide relates the area's intriguing cultural history. Your destination is Kapoloa Falls, which plunges from a crest 300 feet above and cascades across the trail, falling another 200 feet into a deep chasm. You'll be able to walk directly behind the falls for a perfect photo opportunity. Your journey begins from the Kona Pier as you head north, crossing four of the five volcanoes that form the Big Island. Traveling to the northernmost point of the island, you'll witness the island's dramatic lava landscapes and amazing diversity of climates, from the dry, barren west side to the lush, wet windward side. Along the way, your naturalist guide will reveal the island's geologic, cultural and natural history. After a brief stop at the historic Kohala Mule Station, one of Hawaii's best scenic look-outs, you'll be taken by four-wheel drive to the mountain trailhead for your hike through paradise.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. We recommend you dress in shorts or slacks, sturdy shoes and a light jacket. Keep your eyes open for the spinner dolphins, green sea turtles, and manta rays which frequent these waters, (humpback whales in season, Dec-April). Your scenic raft adventure brings you to Kealakekua Bay, where you can swim and snorkel in protected waters. Hear the story of Captain James Cook, the famous British navigator who lost his life here in 1779, and his encounters with the Hawaiians. On the return ride, you'll explore sea caves and lava tubes and learn more about the geology of the island.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. Wear a swimsuit under light clothing and bring a towel. A hat, sunscreen and sunglasses are recommended. This excursion is for adventurous people who can handle exposure to the sun, wind and occasional salt spray. Not recommended for pregnant women or those with back problems. Join us on a rocky ramble off-road adventure up to the cool and misty lavascaped slopes of Hualalai Mountain. Our Pinzgauers are fast and fun, taking us from sea-level to 6,000 ft, where a surreal scene of black lava flows and native dryland forest awaits. See firsthand the geologic forces which created our islands at the heart of Hualalai's 1801 eruption, Ka'upulehu Crater. We'll travel to magnificent coastal viewpoints and stunning lava formations, before exploring the mountain by foot. Walk amidst a forest of native birdsong and scramble through a lava tube – Hualalai has it all!

Your tour includes transportation to and from Honokohau Harbor, a fully equipped sport-fishing boat that will accommodate up to five guests, and an experienced and licensed Captain and crew. Experience is not necessary, and even if you don't catch anything, you're sure to reel in some wonderful memories.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. A hat, sunscreen and sunglasses are recommended. Fish cannot be brought back aboard the cruise ship. No guarantees are made with respect to catching any fish. **THIS TOUR IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**

BODY GLOVE SNORKEL & DOLPHIN SAIL

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal

Come aboard the trimaran *Body Glove* and cruise the Pawai Bay, a protected marine preserve of gorgeous coral reef gardens filled with an array of colored tropical fish, endangered sea turtles and wild dolphins. Along the way, enjoy a breakfast of freshly baked pastries, tropical juices, island fruits and Kona coffee. The *Body Glove* features a spacious upper sun deck, a large shaded cabin, fresh water showers and bathrooms. A 15-foot water slide and high-dive platform are a big hit, great fun for everyone! Your experienced crew will provide you with snorkeling gear and personalized instruction. Note: A buffet-style deli lunch is also provided. Sodas are included and cocktails are available at an additional charge. To purchase alcoholic beverages, guests must be 21 years of age or older. A valid ID is required by law.

KONA CULTURAL & SNORKEL ADVENTURE

Level 2, Age

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

This guided tour will take you to the famous Place of Refuge, set on beautiful Honaunau Bay, and is one of the most authentic and well-preserved archeological sites in Hawaii, where you can tour the grounds and exhibits. Surrounded by crystal blue water and ancient black lava-rock walls, the white sand compound recaptures the days of old Hawaii with its Tiki statues, replicas of traditional outrigger canoes and Halau (thatched huts). Once you have toured the site, you'll be ready to cool off and explore the underwater world of Kahalu'u Beach Park, a perfect snorkeling location. Your guide, a certified Hawaiian lifeguard, will outfit you with top quality snorkeling gear and guide your snorkel adventure. Prior to returning to the pier you will get a chance to visit a working south Kona Coffee Roaster.

Note: Participants must be over 10 years of age and in good physical condition. This tour is not recommended for those with heart conditions or those who cannot swim. Wear bathing suit under clothing, sensible footwear (water shoes are recommended) and bring sunscreen, sunglasses and a towel. Snorkel gear and safety vests are provided. Water cameras highly recommended!

KAMANU CATAMARAN DOLPHIN SAIL & SNORKEL

Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours

Level 2, Meal

Enjoy three activities in one – snorkeling, sailing and dolphin watching (including humpback whales, Dec-April). What could be better than sailing along the beautiful Kona Coast and meeting the resident Hawaiian spinner dolphins, while making your way to Pawai Bay! You will receive snorkel gear and personalized instruction. The underwater topography is amazing, filled with corals, lava cliffs, valley arches and caves. Once in the water, look for rainbow colored reef fish, endangered sea turtles and the elusive manta and eagle rays. After snorkeling, sit back and enjoy the tranquility as light winds fill *Kamanu's* sails as she glides over Kona's brilliant blue waters. A deli lunch of sandwiches, chips and fresh island fruit will be served. Beverages are also included – cold beer, wine, juice and sodas.

Note: Snorkel gear (prescription masks available) and floatation devices are included. Fresh water showers are also available.

KONA OCEAN KAYAK & SNORKEL ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Restrictions

Kayak along the scenic Kona coastline and black lava sea cliffs to Kuamoo Bay. Along the way, see some great sea caves and giant lava tubes; you may even sight the playful dolphin or a green sea turtle! Then jump in the water in a protected cove to snorkel and see some of Hawaii's marine life upclose. Don't worry beginners, a friendly and knowledgeable guide will greet you and provide you with basic paddling and snorkeling instruction and safety information. After your fun day of kayaking and snorkeling, you will make the return to the pier via air-conditioned van.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and in good physical condition. You should expect to paddle at a moderately active pace for approximately three and a half miles round trip. We recommend you wear a bathing suit under light clothing, water shoes and bring sunscreen, sunglasses, a waterproof camera and a towel. Snorkeling gear and safety vests are provided. This tour is not recommended for those with back problems or heart conditions.

KONA SURFING - THE SPORT OF KINGS

Level 2, Age

Your adventure begins with a short coastal cruise to Kahalu'u Bay, where your licensed surf instructor awaits you with state-of-the-art equipment, an explanation of currents, etiquette, and how to stand up in an easygoing atmosphere. Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age, a good swimmer and in good physical condition. Wear a swimsuit and sunscreen as well as sunglasses that cannot fall off. Bring a towel. Tour operates weather permitting.

OUTRIGGER CANOE RIDES

Be prepared for changeable weather conditions. Raingear will be available. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women. Don't forget your camera!

You'll marvel at the Crater's eerie lunar-like landscape of cinder cones and ancient lava formations. The view is absolutely amazing. On clear days, you'll enjoy views of Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea in the distance.

Note: We recommend you wear comfortable clothing and bring a sweater as temperatures range between 40-65 degrees Fahrenheit. We do not guarantee the weather will permit viewing sunrise. Coffee and pastry also included.

HALEAKALA DOWNHILL BICYCLE ADVENTURE AT SUNRISE

Approximate Duration: 8 hours

Level 3, Meal, Age

What would motivate you to wake up in the wee hours of the morning? Would you do it for one of the most spectacular sunrises you'll possible see in your lifetime? Combine this, with the excitement and beauty of biking down a dormant volcano, some 10,000 feet above sea level, and you've created some great memories. Your adventure begins with a van ride to the summit to Mount Haleakala (which means House of the Rising Sun). Enjoy the beauty as you coast over 38 miles at a speed of up to 20 miles per hour, maneuvering through 29 switchbacks on your downhill descent. Complete safety instructions, helmet, windbreaker, gloves and of course a bicycle are provided. Rest assured, all bicycles are custom built and equipped with sixinch drum brakes for maximum stopping capabilities. Continental breakfast and lunch is included.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and five feet tall. You must be a competent rider (no beginners please) and in good health. Pregnant women are prohibited from riding bicycles on this excursion. Bring a jacket or sweatshirt and closed-toe shoes are required. Eye protection is recommended.

HALEAKALA CRATER

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities

This scenic journey takes you through upcountry Maui to the top of the world's largest dormant volcano, Haleakala. You will visit one of Maui's most defining sights, the Iao Needle, a 2,250-foot cinder cone pinnacle that pierces the clouds and dominates its lush surroundings.

Wear comfortable clothes and sensible shoes for boat transfers and navigating the ladder.

Enjoy a stop at the Kaukini Art Gallery, which features only artists of Hawaii, offering you the opportunity to view and purchase exquisite woodcrafts, ceramics, jewelry, Hawaiian quilting and other gifts. The tour continues to a small private Hawaiian village where you can re-live the ways of old Hawaii. As you walk through the family village, your guide will describe what it would have been like to live there centuries ago. Kahakuloa Village is the home to several families who live and practice the ancient customs, including the cultivation of a Hawaii staple food, taro. The residents of Kahakuloa Valley continue to work and care for this land as their ancestors have for over 1,500 years.

Molokini, a crescent moon-shaped islet located less than three miles off Maui's southern coast, lies along Haleakala's southwest rift zone. Scientists at the Hawaiian Volcano Observatory believe that Molokini, whose summit rises about 160 feet above sea level, last erupted about 230,000 years ago. While many geologists believed that the islet was a fairly young volcanic formation, recent evidence suggests that Molokini is much older – possibly older than Haleakala Crater itself. The ocean around Molokini was declared a marine preserve by the State Marine Life Conservations District in 1977. Its crescent shape acts as a fortress that provides protection from waves and powerful currents, making this area one of the top ten snorkel sites in the world and home to more than 250 species of fish including surgeon fish, tangs, parrot fish, Moorish idols and more, some of which are endemic to Hawaii. No matter what part of Molokini's undersea world you choose to explore, you'll encounter crystal-clear waters and schools of colorful fish. Count on us to point out the unique sights you'd easily miss on your own by taking part in our exclusive guided reef tour led by our marine naturalists. We specialize in kids and beginners! After snorkeling at Molokini, the boat makes a second stop at Turtle Arches where you can swim, snorkel and may encounter the Hawaiian green sea turtle!

The Dunes at Maui Lani Golf Course is laid out "much like Royal Troon", according to course architect Robin Nelson. There isn't another site like Maui Lani anywhere else in the world. The terrain upon which The Dunes is built is prime, unspoiled linksland — millon-year old alluvial sand dunes — almost prehistoric in nature. Your journey begins with a short drive to your starting point where your guides give you a safety briefing and paddling techniques. Board your double kayaks and begin your relaxing 2-1/2 mile paddle up the historic Hulei'a River, site of the legendary Menehune Fishpond. As you glide through this beautiful valley, your guides will point out native birds and a variety of plant life lining the shores. Along the way you will pull into the shade of mango trees for a short break at the rope swing area where Indiana Jones escaped the natives in Raiders of the Lost Ark. Enjoy locally baked snacks and a dip in the water. The adventure continues with a 15 to 20 minute walk through the protected jungle trail of the Wildlife Refuge. As you exit the forest, air-conditioned vans will be awaiting to drive you out of the valley.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age, not weigh over 265 lbs; should be in good health and able to stand and walk on uneven surfaces. Your incredible day begins with a narrated drive to the stables, where your experienced guide will provide you with basic riding and safety instructions. For this approximately one-and-a-half hour ride, expert guides will escort you through the ancient Mahaulepu area that draws beach goers, windsurfers and local fishermen. On your ride, you'll experience a variety of scenery and terrain, from pastureland to coastal and mountain vistas. You'll cross over a sand bar and stream, ride past beaches and bays, and see abundant native foliage and birds. Your guides will share ancient legends and local lore. After your ride, you'll be met in a designated area for the relaxing return to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. If under 12 years of age, please notify us so that we can arrange the correct size tack. You must be physically fit and comfortable riding a horse, although experience is not necessary. Height to weight proportional restrictions may apply. Maximum weight of each rider is 250 lbs. Closed-toe shoes are required. Wear comfortable clothing, sunscreen and sunglasses.

TUBING THE DITCH EXPEDITION

Recapture the time of the sugar plantations as you tube historic waterways along the flumes and ditches on the old Lihue Plantation. Your adventure starts with a short drive to the headwaters of the four-mile long Hanamaulu Ditch system where you will begin your two-mile tubing expedition. Grab a tube, don a headlamp, and jump in for a leisurely tubing expedition. Witness Kauai's spectacular engineering feats as you float down the tropical waterway of open ditches, tunnels and flumes all of which were engineered and hand dug in 1912. At the end of your adventure, you'll be whisked away to a charming picnic area for a delicious snack beside a pristine swimming hole. It's a memorable experience for the entire family!

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age and weigh no more than 300 lbs. Water shoes, gloves, helmets, headlamps and a snack and beverages are included. Not recommended for those who are claustrophobic, pregnant women or those with back problems. Wear a swimsuit or quickdrying shorts and shirt. Bring a towel, change of dry clothing, waterproof sunscreen, hat and mosquito repellent.

WAIMEA CANYON DOWNHILL BIKE ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight restrictions

Join us on an amazing downhill bicycle adventure from the rim of the majestic Waimea Canyon, an elevation of 3,600 feet, to Kauai's amazing coastline. From the cruise ship pier you'll be taken by van to the top of Waimea Canyon where you'll be fitted with safety equipment. You will be provided with your own top of the line bike cruiser equipped with wide comfy saddles, high rise handle bars and custom hub mounted drum brakes for ultimate control. Once you've been provided with a safety briefing you will start your 13-mile downhill adventure. Your guides will lead you down smooth winding asphalt roads all the way to the Pacific's blue shores. Stop along the way for great photos and fascinating narratives of Hawaii's history, culture, folklore and legends. Your guides will also identify the native plants, wildlife and trees as you cruise by them. This exciting tour is a fun and exhilarating way to experience the 'Grand Canyon of the Pacific' and its beautiful surrounding forests.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Minimum height requirement is 4'10" and maximum weight is 250 lbs. We recommend you bring sunscreen, sunglasses, camera and a sweatshirt or windbreaker for cool weather at the summit. Wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothing. All equipment is provided. Take a fun downwind kayak trip on the Hule'ia River. After receiving basic safety and paddling instructions you will begin your downwind paddle, which covers about two miles in length. You will travel through the Hule'ia National Wildlife Refuge, a place for the preservation of endangered Hawaiian water birds then paddle past the Alekoko (Menehune) Fishpond. A living archaeological site, the Alekoko Fishpond is a fine example of the ancient Hawaiian's fishing and aquiculture methods that are still in use to this day. Your backdrop will be the magnificent Haupu Mountain Range, a dramatic and majestic 2,000-foot shield volcano that looms nearby over the river. The area is steeped in legend, and your guides will tell you exciting stories about the supernatural inhabitants of the valley in days gone by. After paddling downwind you will leave your kayaks behind and set out on a 3/4 mile guided nature walk through a pristine tropical rainforest. This rainforest contains many different interesting communities of plants, birds and aquatic life, both native and introduced. Your destination is an off-the-beaten-path swimming hole and a gorgeous tropical waterfall! After great kayaking and hiking you will make the pleasant down-river return; rather than paddling back two miles into headwinds, kickback and enjoy the scenery on a truly fun and unique vessel: our double-hulled, powered Hawaiian canoe. Enjoy snacks and cold drinks as you cruise down the beautiful river.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age, not weigh over 265 lbs., should be in good health and able to stand and walk on uneven surfaces for a total of 1 1/2 miles. We recommend that you wear a swimsuit under comfortable clothing, sunscreen, sport sandals with straps or water shoes with good tread (no flip flops or sneakers). Bring your camera, bug repellant and a towel.

NA PALI EXPLORER

Approximate Duration: 7 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Restrictions

Voyage with the dolphins to witness a wonder of the natural world, the Na Pali Coast. Na Pali Explorer, the original Na Pali ocean expedition, takes you to these mystical 4,000 foot high sea cliffs where you are dwarfed by their sheer majesty and color. Sea caves and cascading waterfalls are scattered along this huge green stretch of remote rainforested coastline. The Captain and crew will provide narration on the history and mythology of the area before you take a plunge and snorkel the crystal clear waters teaming with marine life. Enjoy a deli style lunch on board before returning.

You couldn't pick a better time to experience the thrill and excitement of surfing! Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, able to swim and be in reasonable physical condition. Tour will run conditions permitting. You should wear a swimsuit, sunscreen as well as sunglasses that cannot fall off. Bring a towel and water. Surfboard, wax, leash, water shoes and rash guard tops are included. Participants wishing to stay on the beach longer than the time allotted may return to the ship at their own expense. Enjoy beautiful views of Mt. Kawaikini (Kauai's tallest mountain), Mt. Waiale'ale (the wettest spot on earth), Mt. Kahili, and Mt. Kalualea. There we park and have an easy one-and-a-half mile stroll past wild flowers and gorgeous vistas, towards the heart of Kauai, stopping just two miles downstream from the base of Mount Waialeale, which is at the center of the island. Learn about the history and culture of Hawaii from experienced guides in a breathtaking natural environment.

KAUAI SCUBA

Level 2, C-Card

Certified divers, this is a great opportunity to dive in the beautiful waters of Hawaii's oldest island. This two-tank boat dive is a Captain's choice trip depending on the conditions upon arrival. An experienced crew will assist you with dive briefings and some local knowledge of the aquatic life, and then enjoy an escorted dive beneath the waves. Get up close and personal with Hawaii's native fish, or wave to one of the passing green sea turtles that inhabit the area.
